



1. Print out the SO SOPHIE Paper Doll template on A4 sized paper. If you have heavier weight paper, like thin card, that would be ideal.

2.Use your favourite crayons, pencils and markers to colour and decorate your paper doll and her special outfits. Feel free to make your own patterns for the dresses. Maybe you want to add some more flowers or bows or heart shapes. Think of the colour combinations. You may even want to add some glitter! It's up to you. There is no right or wrong. The important thing is not to rush, take your time and just enjoy the process of creating!

3. Take a pair of small scissors and cut out your paper doll and her outfits very carefully. Make sure you include the base and support part of the doll and the little tabs on her outfits and hair accessories!

ATTENTION: Please supervise/help young children with this step as it needs precision and caution!

4.To get your paper doll ready to dress up, fold across the three dotted lines. Add some glue to the little square at the bottom and stick to the back of the doll so that she can stand (you will be creating a triangle if you view the doll from the side).



5. Fold the tabs on the dresses and hair accessories to the back and dress your doll with the outfit of the day (OOTD)! Doesn't she look cute? I'm sure she does!

6.Don't forget to give your doll a name and share a photo of her on Instagram/Facebook tagging, @loveartandbeyond or @sophieadamou respectively and using the hashtag, #sosophiepaperdollclub That way I can see your paper doll and we can all see each other's! Yav!
